

From the Desk of Chief Bruck - Always Lock Your Vehicles



The nice weather of spring brings us outdoors for yard work, sports, cookouts and fun. The warmer weather also brings out less desirable culprits. So far in April, we have had a rash of thefts from cars. Neighborhoods on and around Easter Dr., Meadowlark Dr., Fairview Dr., Sheri Dr. and Union Rd. have all experienced these thefts.

Typically the thieves are going through unlocked cars and taking small items that can easily be carried such as small electronic devices (cell phones, GPS units and laptops). They normally do not break out windows unless a very valuable item can be seen inside your car. These thefts are what we call "crimes of opportunity". That is, the thief wanders around, and if he or she finds an unlocked car, they take what they can from it.

We need to work together to make our neighborhoods safe. There are three things each of us can do to protect us from these thefts:

- ☑ Keep our cars locked
- ☑ Keep our valuables inside our home
- ☑ Call the police whenever you see or hear anything suspicious.

By doing these three things, we can eliminate the opportunity for criminals to get our valuables. They will go somewhere else where the opportunity does exist. Free Well Water Testing on May 18th

The Warren County Soil and Water Conservation District will be conducting a Well Water Testing Event at the Carlisle High School on Thursday, May 18th from 4:30pm to 6:00pm.



- ☑ Bring in a well water sample by filling a clean bottle or container, that holds at least 16.9 oz, with the first draw of water in the morning (or after 6 hours of non-use).
- ☑ Free confidential nitrate, nitrite and iron screening.
- ☑ Purchase a bacteria test kit at a reduced cost (\$20) or other water tests at the event.

First 40 water samples in the door will receive a free lead, copper, and arsenic test.
