# First Reading of Ordinances and Resolutions:

RES. 16-20 A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER OR HER DESIGNEE TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT TWO MONTGOMERY COUNTY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT APPLICATIONS AND TO EXECUTE AND SIGN ALL AGREEMENTS NECESSARY FOR THE COMPLETION OF THE GRANT CONTRACTS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Mrs. Duffy explained that during Tuesday's Council meeting, she mistakenly informed Council that only the rule to adopt as emergency language and waive the 30-day referendum period required a minimum vote of five. This is not accurate. Section 5.03 of the Carlisle Charter requires that the rule requiring three readings shall only be suspended upon a vote of five members, not four. This means that Resolution 16-20, which was presented and voted on as a single reading during the June 23<sup>rd</sup> Council meeting was not properly adopted.

Resolution 16-20 is before Council today for reconsideration. The resolution is being presented as an emergency in order for the Village to apply FY2020 CDBG funds by the July 3<sup>rd</sup> deadline. This means

that a minimum of five affirmative votes will be required in order to adopt as an emergency with one reading only per Sections 5.03 and 5.05 of the Carlisle Charter.

Mrs. Kemper made a motion to suspend the rules requiring three readings, and have one reading by title only, and declaring an emergency, seconded by Mrs. Bilbrey.
