Discussion Items:

Communication

Mr. Lohr stated he is glad to do a regular sit down with each Council member. He and Mr. Bicknell have talked about doing it monthly or every other week. He will check in with them later in the week to see what each one thinks and get something scheduled. Mr. Lohr and Council Members discussed weekend updates for Council. Overall, the consensus was they all appreciated the communication from him. Mr. Lohr will continue that.

Mr. Lohr stated in a couple conversations with Council Members that training sessions came up. For example, some Councils like to receive public records training or ethics training. He asked if there was a general feeling that you would be more comfortable if someone were brought in to talk about public records and how to deal with emailing, for example agenda items or anything else that might pop up as a public record. Council and Manager agreed that a public records law discussion with the Law Director would be helpful.

Street Lighting Assessments

Mr. Lohr had put this item on the Work Session Agenda, but he did some more research and was able to answer his own question. Mr. Lohr stated that he would proceed with the streetlighting assessment process that has already been started. All agreed to consider changes to the process for the upcoming year.

Planning and Zoning Discussion

Council asked questions about various development topics and potential zoning code issues. Among these were the proposed dollar store to be located near Central Ave. and Sunset Dr. and the recent purchase by a private investor of property on Central Ave. near the railroad underpass.
